# **UTILITY WORKER PROGRAM**





### Qualifications:

- Must have a valid California Driver License
- Must be 18 years or older
- Must be a resident of Los Angeles or Inyo County in California, or a County in other states where LADWP operates facilities

## **Requirements:**

- 1. Sign the Utility Worker and Office Trainee books digitally at www.ibewlocal18.org
- Complete a three-day training period that includes classroom instruction, exams, giving a presentation and passing an interview. You will be evaluated for attendance, punctuality, participation, problem solving, work ethic, teamwork and teachability.
- 3. Secure a Work Readiness Certificate upon completion of the three-day training period

Upon completion of all requirements, you will begin your work as an exempt Utility Worker or Office Trainee. For six months, you will be trained on the job and receive regular assessments. After completion, you will be placed on a qualifying Civil Service eligible list for appointment to a parallel classification. You will then work another six months and you must pass your probation. With successful completion, you will be eligible for transfer to a permanent Civil Service classification.
